



### **Team Registration Fees – November 2023**

SWF have revised some of its registration fees – this has included a reduced fee for SWFL clubs to reflect the short transition season which will help the league align with the rest of the pyramid for the 2023/24 season; a slight increase across some youth and highland league teams; and a reduction on the senior community membership fees to help encourage more recreational players into our game.

With these fees, member clubs will benefit from SWF administering all league and cup competitions; access to first aid courses at the Hampden Clinic; SWF's insurance packages (with new rates itemised below); governance support; CWPO networking and support; PVG processing and general club services to help grow and develop the game.

We recognise the significant work clubs do in order to help support the growing number of women and girls to play the sport we all love and SWF looks forward to working together for a successful season ahead.

## Team Membership Type Descriptions

Team Membership Type	Description
SWFL	An established team who wishes to enter a local, adult league competition in a more relaxed, yet competitive environment. 2023 price reflects that these leagues will re-establish the link to the adult pyramid and will become the entry level for new clubs.
Highlands and Islands	An established team who wishes to enter a local, adult league competition in a more relaxed, yet competitive environment
14s, 16s & 18s	Established teams who wish to enter a local 11-a-side (or 9v9 Creative Clause) Youth Regional League with weekly, competitive fixtures within the Club Pathway
12s	An established team who wishes to enter a local 7v7 or 9v9 Games Programme with weekly fixtures within the <i>Club Pathway</i> . Note that Games Programmes shall be reviewed and reset every 12-weeks to ensure the optimal development opportunities for players.

<p>5 – 7s or 8 – 1s (1 fee per Club)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 5 – 7s 4v4</li> <li>• 8 – 10s 5v5</li> <li>• 8 – 10s 7v7</li> </ul>	<p>With a limit of 20 players per team type, clubs should register the relevant number of small sided activity teams. Clubs are encouraged to allocate players into a suitable group centred on player development and not age. Hence, players are <b>not</b> bound by originally assigned small-sided teams and may move as deemed appropriate. <b>Clubs must register paid team type before registering any further, free small-sided team types as bullet pointed</b></p>
<p>Community Membership   12s</p>	<p>A group of players who do not wish to or cannot enter the weekly 12s Games Programme of fixtures. Instead, <i>Community Membership</i> teams may enter an SWF Contacts HUB of similar teams who prefer arranging activity in their own time and need more time to prepare to enter the <i>SWF Club Pathway</i>. This team type still allows teams to register under SWF, purchase insurance and benefit from other SWF member opportunities</p>
<p>Community Membership   14s</p>	<p>A group of players who do not wish to or cannot enter the 14s 11v11 league competition. Instead, <i>Community Membership</i> teams may enter an SWF Contacts HUB of similar teams who prefer arranging activity in their own time or need more time to prepare to enter the <i>SWF Club Pathway</i>. <b>If numbers permit</b>, a 14s 9v9 weekly Games Programme may be offered per region to allow teams to prepare for entry to <i>Club Pathway</i>. This team type still allows teams to register under SWF, purchase insurance and benefit from other SWF member opportunities</p>
<p>Community Membership   16s</p>	<p>A group of players who do not wish to or cannot enter the 16s 11v11 league competition. Instead, <i>Community Membership</i> teams may enter an SWF Contacts HUB of similar teams who prefer arranging activity in their own time or need more time to prepare to enter the <i>SWF Club Pathway</i>. <b>If numbers permit</b>, a 16s weekly Games Programme may be offered per region to allow teams to prepare for entry to <i>Club Pathway</i>. This team type still allows teams to register under SWF, purchase insurance and benefit from other SWF member opportunities</p>
<p>Community Membership   18s</p>	<p>A group of players who do not wish to or cannot enter the 18s 11v11 league competition. Instead, <i>Community Membership</i> teams may enter an SWF Contacts HUB of</p>

	<p>similar teams who prefer arranging activity in their own time or need more time to prepare to enter the SWF <i>Club Pathway</i>. <b>If numbers permit</b>, an 18s weekly Games Programme may be offered per region to allow teams to prepare for entry to <i>Club Pathway</i>. This team type still allows teams to register under SWF, purchase insurance and benefit from other SWF member opportunities</p>
<p>Community Membership   Senior</p>	<p>A group of players who wish to focus purely on recreational football. <i>Community Membership Senior</i> teams may be supported by SFA Club Development Officers to arrange activity without the pressure of being part of a league. Teams may also enter an SWF Contacts HUB of similar teams who prefer arranging activity in their own time or need more time to prepare to enter the SWF Regional, Senior Pathway. This team type still allows teams to register under SWF, purchase insurance and benefit from other SWF member opportunities</p>
