

PowerPundits 2026 Competition – Terms and Conditions

1. Promoter

The promoter of the PowerPundits 2026 competition (the “**Competition**”) is Scottish Power UK Plc, a company incorporated in Scotland with registered number SC117120 and having its registered office at 320 St. Vincent Street, Glasgow, G2 5AD (“**ScottishPower**”), in partnership with Scottish Women’s Football (“**SWF**”), the Scottish Women’s Premier League (“**SWPL**”), and Stripe PR & Communications Limited (“**Stripe Communications**”).

2. Eligibility

- The Competition is open to girls **aged 8–12 years** as at the date of entry (each an “**Entrant**”).
 - Entrants must be **resident in Scotland**.
 - Entrants must be actively involved in grassroots football through an SWF-affiliated club.
 - All entries must be submitted by and **with the consent of a parent or legal guardian**.
 - Only **one entry per Entrant** will be accepted.
 - A parent or legal guardian may submit entries on behalf of more than one Entrant (provided the Entrants meet the eligibility criteria).
 - Entries open on Friday 11 September 2026 at 9am and close on Friday 23 October 2026 at 9am.
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3. How to Enter

- To enter, the parent/legal guardian must complete and submit for each Entrant:
 - the **PowerPundits 2026 Consent Form**; and
 - a written entry (maximum 250 words) from the Entrantvia the official form provided. Please note that postal or email entries will not be accepted.
- The entry must include:
 1. Why the Entrant loves football.
 2. Who their SWPL hero is; and
 3. One question they have always wanted to ask that player.
- Entries not submitted in accordance with these Terms and Conditions, or which are delayed, incomplete, or ineligible will not be accepted. No responsibility is accepted for delayed, incomplete or ineligible entries.
- For the avoidance of doubt, an entry will not be considered **unless it is accompanied by a fully completed PowerPundits 2026 Consent Form**.
- The parent/legal guardian is responsible for ensuring the written entry does not infringe the rights of any third party.

- By participating in the Competition, the parent/legal guardian agrees to be bound by these Terms and Conditions on behalf of the Entrant.
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4. Judging and Selection of Winners

- All eligible entries will be reviewed by a judging panel including representatives from ScottishPower and Stripe Communications.
 - Ten entries will be shortlisted and asked to submit a short video.
 - Entries will be judged by the panel on **creativity, enthusiasm, and passion for the game**.
 - The panel's decision is **final**, and no correspondence will be entered into.
 - Six (6) winners will then be selected by the judging panel and notified by **Friday 27 November 2026** via the contact details provided in their **PowerPundits 2026** Consent Form.
 - If the Entrant's designated parent/legal guardian cannot be contacted within five (5) working days, ScottishPower reserves the right to offer the prize to another Entrant.
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5. The Prize

- Each winner will:
 1. Conduct a filmed Q&A with a player or players within the SWPL, who will be either the SWPL hero named in the winner's Competition entry or a player(s) on their named hero's team. Please note that the player will be selected based on availability of the SWPL team.
 2. Feature in ScottishPower social media content (which shall include videos, photos and recordings of the Entrant) celebrating their journey. For further details, see the PowerPundits Privacy Notice [here](#)
 - The prize is non-transferable, non-refundable, and no cash alternative is available.
 - Dates for filming and training will be agreed between ScottishPower, SWF, SWPL, and the winners' clubs, subject to player availability.
 - For the avoidance of doubt, each Entrant is eligible to win only once during the Competition.
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6. Filming & Content Use

- Once winners have been selected by the judging panel in accordance with paragraph 4 above, the designated parent/legal guardian will be required to complete and return an additional parental consent and image release form before the Entrant may participate in any prize-related activities involving filming, photography or content creation.
- If the Entrant's designated parent/legal guardian does not complete and return the required form(s) within the timeframe specified by ScottishPower,

ScottishPower reserves the right to withdraw the prize and offer it to another Entrant.

- By entering these Terms and Conditions, the parent/legal guardian grants Stripe Communications the right to film, photograph, and record the Entrant during the prize activities.
 - The parent/legal guardian grants use of this content in all media worldwide, including social media, websites, press, and promotional materials.
 - Any filming, photography, or content use will be governed by and reflected in the PowerPundits Privacy Notice [here](#) and PowerPundits 2026 Consent Form.
 - The parent/legal guardian may be asked to sign a separate image release form on behalf of the Entrant before participation.
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7. Data Protection

- The personal data provided will be used solely for the purposes of administering this Competition and will be processed in accordance with the PowerPundits Privacy Notice [here](#).
 - Contact details will not be shared with third parties.
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8. General

- ScottishPower reserves the right to (i) cancel, amend, or suspend the Competition or any part of it; (ii) refuse individual participation (provided it is acting reasonably); and (iii) alter these Terms and Conditions at any time.
 - ScottishPower reserves the right to substitute the prize with one of equal or greater value if circumstances beyond its control make it necessary to do so.
 - The Competition is governed by the laws of Scotland and subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Scottish courts.
 - Any questions regarding the eligibility of an Entrant's entry will be decided by ScottishPower (acting reasonably), whose decision shall be final and binding.
